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1. What is Ziptrak® PanoView®? How does this differ from other Ziptrak® blinds?

PanoView® is another innovation by Ziptrak® Australia. It is a super wide blind that consists of two sections, which are joined at site to form a single frame.

Most elevators and stairwells of high-rise buildings in Singapore can only accommodate blinds of up to 3.4m in width, which effectively limits the width of the blind that can be installed; but with Ziptrak® PanoView®, you can now have a single blind of up to 6m wide, so you can enjoy your view without a post in between.

2. Is Ziptrak® PanoView® weaker since there's no post in between? What is the wind load that Ziptrak® PanoView® can take?

Ziptrak® blinds have gone through extensive R&D to ensure that they hold up well in extreme weather conditions.

In recent wind load tests conducted by TÜV SÜD, Ziptrak® PanoView® blinds were proven to be able to withstand a static load equivalent to wind speeds of 260km/hr, for a 2m by 2m blind. This test demonstrates the robustness of Ziptrak® blinds. Do note that fabrics can still become stretched in extreme high winds. To minimise this, we recommend that the blinds be fully retracted in severe weather conditions.

3. Is having one Ziptrak® PanoView® blind more expensive than having two Ziptrak® blinds?

It will depend on the size of the blind required. For example, for balconies that are between 3.2m to 4.8m wide, a single Ziptrak® PanoView® blind tends to be more cost effective than two Ziptrak® blinds (which comes with a post in between). In addition, if you're looking to motorise your blinds, you'll only need one motor for a single Ziptrak® PanoView® blind, instead of two motors for two blinds.

4. For wide or tall blinds, will there be any fabric joints? What will it look like?

This will depend on the height or width of the blind that's required, versus the roll width of the selected fabric. For example, if the height of the installation is 3m or below, and the fabric selected has a roll width of 3m, you will not have any joint lines. Most of our fabric selections are in rolls of 3m.

If the height or width of the blind exceeds the width of the fabric roll, the fabric will be joined to make a single piece of fabric. A fabric joint will be of the same color and material; the opaque 20mm joint will only be slightly visible. The joint line will be very neat.

5. Can Ziptrak® PanoView® be motorised?

Yes, Ziptrak® PanoView® can be motorised.

6. Will a manual Ziptrak® PanoView® be very heavy to move since it's so wide?

Manual Ziptrak® blinds can be easily operated with one hand, regardless of size, due to the patented Ziptrak® spring-balanced system. The weight of the fabric is borne by the Ziptrak® SuperSpring, which means the blind remains light in your hands.

The SuperSpring comes in different sizes, and each blind is matched with the appropriate SuperSpring, so as to remain light for users, regardless of size.

7. Will Ziptrak® PanoView® sag in the middle since it's so wide?

All blinds that are wider than 4m tend to have a slight deflection. This is common even in traditional cabled systems or any track-guided system. This deflection at the bottom bar will actually help to straighten the fabric, when the blind is in a partially open position. The performance of the blind will not be affected.

8. What is the maximum width and height possible for Ziptrak® PanoView®? Is it the same for manual and motorised systems?

Ziptrak® PanoView® can cover spaces of up to 6m wide and 3.4m high, for both manual and motorised systems. If you require taller systems, please check with your Ziptrak® retailer.

Do note that for high-rise apartments, factors that affect the maximum width and height of the installation, such as the dimensions of the elevator and stairwell, need to be taken into consideration.

9. What is the warranty for Ziptrak® PanoView®? Is it the same for manual and motorised systems?

For warranty terms, please check with your retailer or vendor, as the terms may differ between them.
